ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT SYSTEM SCOPE STATEMENT

Fleet Readiness Center Southwest (FRCSW) has determined the boundaries and applicability of the environmental management system (EMS) to establish its scope. The scope of this EMS includes the policies, procedures, and requirements of the International Organization for Standardization (ISO) 14001. FRCSW has determined that there are no exclusions to the ISO 14001 within the activities identified in the FRCSW's EMS. In determining the scope, the following were considered:

- External and internal issues relevant to our organization
- Compliance obligations from interested parties
- Our organizational units, functions, and physical boundaries
- Our activities, products, and services
- Our authority and ability to exercise control and influence

The scope of FRCSW's EMS includes all FRCSW operations and processes associated with aviation maintenance, repair, and overhaul, as well as the environmental aspects and impacts associated with those processes, located at Naval Base Coronado (NBC). See attachment, reflecting the physical building locations of our tenancy within the boundaries of NBC.

The scope excludes Aircraft Intermediate Maintenance Department (AIMD) operations. It excludes Navy base activities for active duty military, such as pilots' safety while testing the aircraft, fast food franchises, and activities on the transient aircraft carriers docked at the base harbor. In addition, FRCSW's EMS does not cover off-site locations. FRCSW off-site locations shall follow the host command's EMS with assistance as needed from the FRCSW Environmental Program Office (EPO).
